



ENGAGING YOUR CHILD IN THE COLLEGE PROCESS

- Initiating Conversations

Start with open-ended questions to explore college preferences.

What type of campus environment do you feel you would thrive in?

What subjects do you like studying and why?

Explore together what factors are most important for their college experience.

- Class Size: Small classes or large lectures?
- Location: Urban campus or rural setting?
- Campus Resources: Libraries, labs, sports facilities.
- Cultural Aspects: Diversity, arts, and community engagement.





ENGAGING YOUR CHILD IN THE COLLEGE PROCESS

- Collaborative Exploration

Explore colleges and universities together.

- Attend college fairs, information sessions, and campus tours for a hands-on feel.
- Encourage interactions with current students, alumni, and admissions officers for insider perspectives.

Evaluate options.

- Pros and Cons: Discuss what each college offers.
- Alignment with Goals: How does the school fit your child's academic and personal ambitions?





ENGAGING YOUR CHILD IN THE COLLEGE PROCESS



- Parental Role

Encourage your child to take the lead in the college search and application process, while you provide support and insight when needed.

Support Strategies.

- Be mindful of your child's workload and stress levels.
- Offer assistance with organization and planning.
- Be ready to listen and provide emotional support during challenging times.

Celebrate Milestones.

- Acknowledge every effort and progress, big or small.
- Emphasize the value of resilience and self-esteem, regardless of outcomes.
